by most others on the road.**

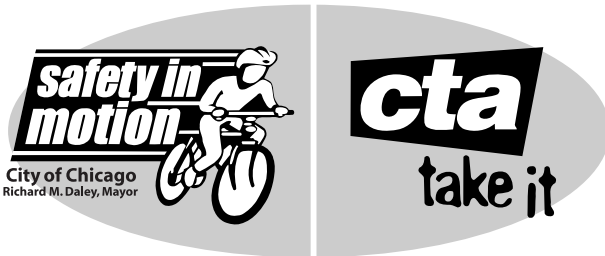
Want other road users to treat you as an equal? Act like one!

Bicycle riders who obey traffic laws:

- Make it easy for others to predict what they'll do.
- Have fewer crashes.
- Help motorists see that bikes belong on the road.

How can you get respect on the road?

- Stop at red lights.
- Yield to other vehicles at stop signs.
- Signal before turning or changing lanes.
- When stopped, don't block crosswalks.
- When passing other bikers, call out "on your left" or "on your right."
